January 19th, 2026

Call to Order

- Marion has asked if they could take the Engine to Indianapolis for the FDIC School and trade show. This show starts the 23rd of April. Grand River Fire Dept would take delivery late April then. They are offering \$5000 and possibly some passes to the Exhibit hall. The board was in favor of it.
